



CARROLLWOOD DAY SCHOOL SUN SCREEN PROCEDURE

The 2021 Florida Statutes 1002.20 (3) (m): *Sun-protective measures in school*. A student may possess and use a topical sunscreen product while on school property or at a school-sponsored event or activity without a physician's note or prescription if the product is regulated by the United States Food and Drug Administration for over-the-counter use to limit ultraviolet light-induced skin damage.

Carrollwood Day School has established these age-appropriate procedures for children in each division:

Middle and Upper School:

Your child may carry sunscreen with them for appropriate use provided it complies with the aforementioned guidelines. Your child must be capable of applying sunscreen independently.

Elementary School:

Parent/guardian may supply a small sized bottle/tube of sunscreen for your child in a clear plastic bag, labeled with their name and date of birth, provided it complies with the aforementioned guidelines. Your child must be capable of applying sunscreen independently.

ECC:

Parent/guardian may supply a small sized bottle/tube of sunscreen for your child in a clear plastic bag, labeled with their name and date of birth, provided it complies with the aforementioned guidelines. Assistance with application can be provided if documented in writing and signed by a parent/guardian.
