IB DP TOK Exhibition: Summer Assignment

Over the summer students should prepare their TOK Exhibition for display. TOK Exhibitions will be put on public display for the entire CDS community to view during the month of September. Displays must include 1) The <u>Exhibition Prompt</u> clearly printed in large font at the top of the display; 2) <u>Your Name</u> clearly printed at the bottom left of the display; 3) Each of <u>Your 3 Objects</u> (usually in the form of clear, color photos); 4) <u>Your Commentary</u> on each object. This display will present your TOK Exhibition to the CDS community. Be creative and make something you will be proud to display to the community as a significant example of your work.

May 2023: Semester Wrap Up

By Friday May 26, 2023, students should have met with their EE supervisors to discuss their research question, their sources and their EE work plan for the summer. Also, students should have completed their first mandatory reflection and logged it into ManageBac under the Planning and Progress Form tab for their EE. If you have not completed these tasks, you must complete them ASAP.

June – July 2023: Summer Writing

The IB recommends 40 total hours for the EE project. The bulk of your EE research and a significant portion of your writing should be completed over the summer. **November 15, 2023 is the benchmark date for the** <u>first submission of a complete EE to your EE supervisor</u>. Students should not attempt to fit 40 hours of EE work into the fall semester along with their coursework, college applications/essays and IB Internal Assessment (IA) deadlines. Students should avoid unnecessary stress in the Fall by completing as much of their EE work as possible over the summer.

August 2023: Post summer EE review

A review of your summer work and progress on your EE will be conducted during the first weeks of school. Keep in mind that 1) you must follow the schedule and satisfy the EE benchmarks as set out by your EE supervisor and the EE coordinator; 2) failure to meet your EE benchmarks will jeopardize your status as a full IB Diploma Program candidate; 3) in particular, failure to meet the <u>November 15</u>, 2023 benchmark for the first submission of a complete EE will jeopardize your status as a full IB Diploma Program candidate, reach out and communicate with your EE supervisor, Dr. Whitaker, or Mrs. Hsu.
